



2011 Creative Space Grantee Project Summaries

CRSP 2011

Chinese Culture Foundation of San Francisco \$13,500

Project Summary

To support a planning process to upgrade Chinese Culture Foundation's Orientation and Exhibit areas in its 3000 square foot gallery space. The funds will pay for fees for the Lead Planning Consultant, Gordon Chun Design (who designed the CCC Galleries and early exhibits).

Chinese Historical Society of America \$15,200

Project Summary

To support the Chinese Historical Society of America's second phase of renovation of the Museum Main Hall and Rotating Galleries. Funds from the grant will be used to support design/project management, materials, fabrication and installation costs related to the project. This project will take place from March through September 2011

CounterPulse \$18,000

Project Summary

To support CounterPULSE in improving the safety and efficiency of its theatrical lighting system by implementing a power safety upgrade. This project includes installing code-compliant circuits, upgrading the theater's electrical power, separating the audience and performance area circuits, and relocating the switches for these circuits to the theater entrance.

Croatian American Cultural Center \$16,000

Project Summary

To support the Croatian American Cultural Center in making capital improvements to their roof, walls, and security doors.

Intersection for the Arts

\$13,500

Project Summary

To support Intersection for the Arts in pre-development planning related to the acquisition of a permanent space that will serve as the primary home for the organization's performing arts, visual arts, education, community engagement, and residency programs; as well as its administrative offices and the Intersection Incubator program which provides fiscal sponsorship, resources, and support services to more than 100 emerging organization and projects each year.

San Francisco Mime Troupe

\$16,875

Project Summary

To support the San Francisco Mime Troupe in replacing much of the roof of their building. The roof leaks badly during the rainy season and the intrusion of water effects several areas of operation including after-school theater workshops for youth and the large stock of stored costumes and set pieces which are frequently recycled and rented to other companies.

Women's Audio Mission

\$6,100

Project Summary

To support Women's Audio Mission in improving the safety of staff, members and the general public by improving facility security within the building through the installation of a video camera system, upgrading internal and external door locks to high-security locks, strengthening doors and reinforcing door frames.

Z Space Studio

\$16,000

Project Summary

To support Z Space in Phase II of their plans to upgrade their space in Project Artaud including installing professional signage in front of the theater, making the bathrooms more appealing and upgrading the lighting equipment. Improvements will impact organizational sustainability due to a reliance on rental income.
