CALL FOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO ARTS COMMISSION STREET ARTISTS PROGRAM

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The Advisory Committee of Street Artists and Crafts Examiners advises the Arts Commission on matters relating to the wares produced by street artists, consisting of meetings to examine the arts and crafts of artist applicants seeking licenses to sell their items in public places (these meetings are held on a monthly basis, generally the last Thursday morning of each month); possible weekend assignments to monitor street artists for violations; and possible visits to artists' studios for further verification that artists are making their own work.

The Advisory Committee consists of 5 members who are appointed by the Mayor. Four of the members must be experienced artists or craftspersons and one member must be an art educator. Each member is appointed from among 3 people whose names are submitted by the Arts Commission to the Mayor for appointment. Each member serves a 2 year term. Each member is allotted 35 meetings/assignments and receives compensation of \$100 per screening/assignment.

Interested persons with applicable backgrounds may submit a cover letter, resume and responses to the supplemental questionnaire (found below) to Arts Commission, Street Artists Program, 25 Van Ness Avenue, Suite 345, San Francisco, CA, 94102.

Questionnaire:

1. Are you an artist or craftsperson? If so, what art or craft are you proficient in?
2. What is your teaching or educational experience? Are you currently teaching? If so, where and for how long?
3. Why are you interested in becoming an Advisory Committee member of the Street Artists Program?
4. What special quality will you bring to the program; what will you contribute?
5. How much time can you contribute to the Advisory Committee?
